

SAFETY RULES & CODE OF CONDUCT

Enforcement of these rules is necessary to keep our IMPBA sanction insurance that covers our liability when we practice or race. Also some of these rules are Sedgwick County Park policy. Conduct is common courtesy to your fellow boater and the public that watches us.

1. No swimming for any reason.
2. No launching a boat when pickup boat is not on the shore line.
3. Before you launch a boat look for on coming boats in the front straight away. Do not launch a boat with another boat in the front straight away.
4. No running backwards on the course. Run the course clockwise.
5. No cutting the course. If you need to test your boat do it without other boats on the course.
6. No foul language or abusive language of any kind.
7. When there are two dead boats on the course, do not launch your boat. Or if a dead boat is taking on water do not launch your boat. Let the pickup boat out to retrieve the boats.
8. No launching a boat without a frequency clip. This also goes for R/C cars brought to the site.
9. No boats launched when children are on the shoreline in front of the drivers stand.

NOTE: Parents if you bring your children to the site, then it is your responsibility to keep them safe by knowing where there are all the times.

10. No driving from the shoreline. Use the drivers stand.
11. Do not launch your own boat. You are to have someone launch your boat and that person has to be with you on the drivers stand while you are running your boat. That person also will pickup your boat when you come in to the shore line.
12. A boat that acts like it is not in control will be called in and the driver will have to do a range check and prove that they have control of there boat.
13. Items that turn into trash need to collected and deposited in the proper trash container before you leave the site.
14. We share the lake with everyone. Please be courteous.
